Instructions for use and application of the form MAL

This **application form (MAL)** is intended only for transportable earth stations which need a short time licence for less than one year. This application form is limited to the frequency range 14.0-14.5 GHz. For other cases the form MA shall be used.

Name of earth station is given only if the earth station has been granted a licence in Finland before.

Geographical area of use should be limited to the actual area needed: street address, part of town, town, county or the whole country.

Purpose of use is e.g. SNG.

Center frequency and **Total bandwidth** are given so that it covers the whole frequency range where the earth station is to be used. In case of one transponder the total bandwidth is the bandwidth of the transponder.

Modulation is either analogue or digital.

Earth stations that operate at 14.0-14.25 GHz and that fulfill the requirements in ECC/DEC/(06)03 are exempted from licensing.
